Writing towards the expected standard								
The pupil can, after discussion with the teacher								
Write sentences that are sequenced to form a short narrative (real or fictional)								
Demarcate some sentences with capital letters and full stops								
Segment spoken words into phonemes and representing these by graphemes, spelling some correctly and making phonically plausible attempts at others								
Form lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place								
Form lower-case letters of the correct size relative to one another in some of their writing								
Use spacing between words

The pupil can, after discussion with the teacher.								
Write simple, coherent narratives about personal experiences and those of others (real and fictional),								
Write about real events, recording these simply and clearly								
Demarcate most sentences with capital letters and full stops								
Use question marks correctly when required								
Use present and past tense mostly correctly and consistently								
Use co-ordination (and/or/but)								
Use some subordination (when/if/that/because)								
Segment spoken words into phonemes and representing these by graphemes, spelling many correctly and making phonically plausible attempts at others								
Spell some words with contracted forms								
Form capital letters and digits of the correct size, orientation and relationship to one another and to lower-case letters								
Use spacing between words that reflects the size of the letters

The pupil can write for different purposes, after discussion with the teacher								
Write effectively and coherently for different purposes, drawing on their to inform the vocabulary and grammar of their writing								
Make simple additions, revisions and pro-reading corrections to their own writing								
Use the punctuation taught at KS1 mostly correctly								
Use diagonal and horizontal strokes needed to join some letters
