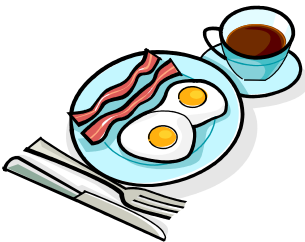


Catering Success
