There's plenty to look forward to this term, a summer packed with many exciting events to look forward to.

Year 1 visit the seaside



Year One enjoyed a visit to Weston -Super -Mare this week. Despite the wind and rain they had a wonderful time building sandcastles, going on a donkey ride and having an ice lolly on the promenade. The children thoroughly enjoyed themselves and were keen to point out the different human and physical features they recognised from learning about Weston in their Geography lessons.

Year 4 and 5 explore Overbury



Year 4 and 5 had a fantastic time at Overbury Farm this week. Overbury is an arable farm with sheep, set in 1565 Hectares and children had a full-days program of visits and activities during the day. At the lower end of the estate, children visited the kitchen garden where we saw how they grow a vast range of fruit, veg and herbs, learnt how they make compost and planted seeds. We learnt all about breeding pheasants including handling some hatching eggs and recently hatch chicks. They also had over a million pounds worth of machinery used to plough fields, water crops and plant seeds that the children saw. On the upper end of the estate, we met a shepherdess and her sheep, a tree feller and a joiner. We also explored the woodland, identifying different trees and smelling the wild garlic. On top of that, we met a blacksmith and a potter and observed them plying their craft. It was a hugely fun, interesting and informative day leaving us with heads full of new knowledge and a deeper appreciation of where our food comes from and why we need to care for the environment.

Year 3 visit Nature in Art



On Wednesday, Year 2 went on a trip to Nature in Art, in Gloucester, ahead of our upcoming art unit based around the artist Andy Goldsworthy, whose artwork was inspired by nature.

During the morning, we took part in two workshops. The first activity was to create a multi-layered collage using newspaper and tissue paper. For the second activity we created butterflies and dragonflies using wire and glass paint. During the afternoon the children spent their time creating observational drawings of sculptures in the gardens, a walk around the art gallery, and even a visit to the artist in residence, who taught us all about how to create a variety of lines, patterns and effects using a paint brush. What a wonderful way to start the half term!

Collective Worship



Collective Worship on Wednesday was led by a live band from Holy Trinity, consisting of guitar, bass guitar, Cajon, viola and vocals. They led us in some of our favourite songs as well as a new song including 'My Lighthouse', 'Our God' and 'Great Big God'.

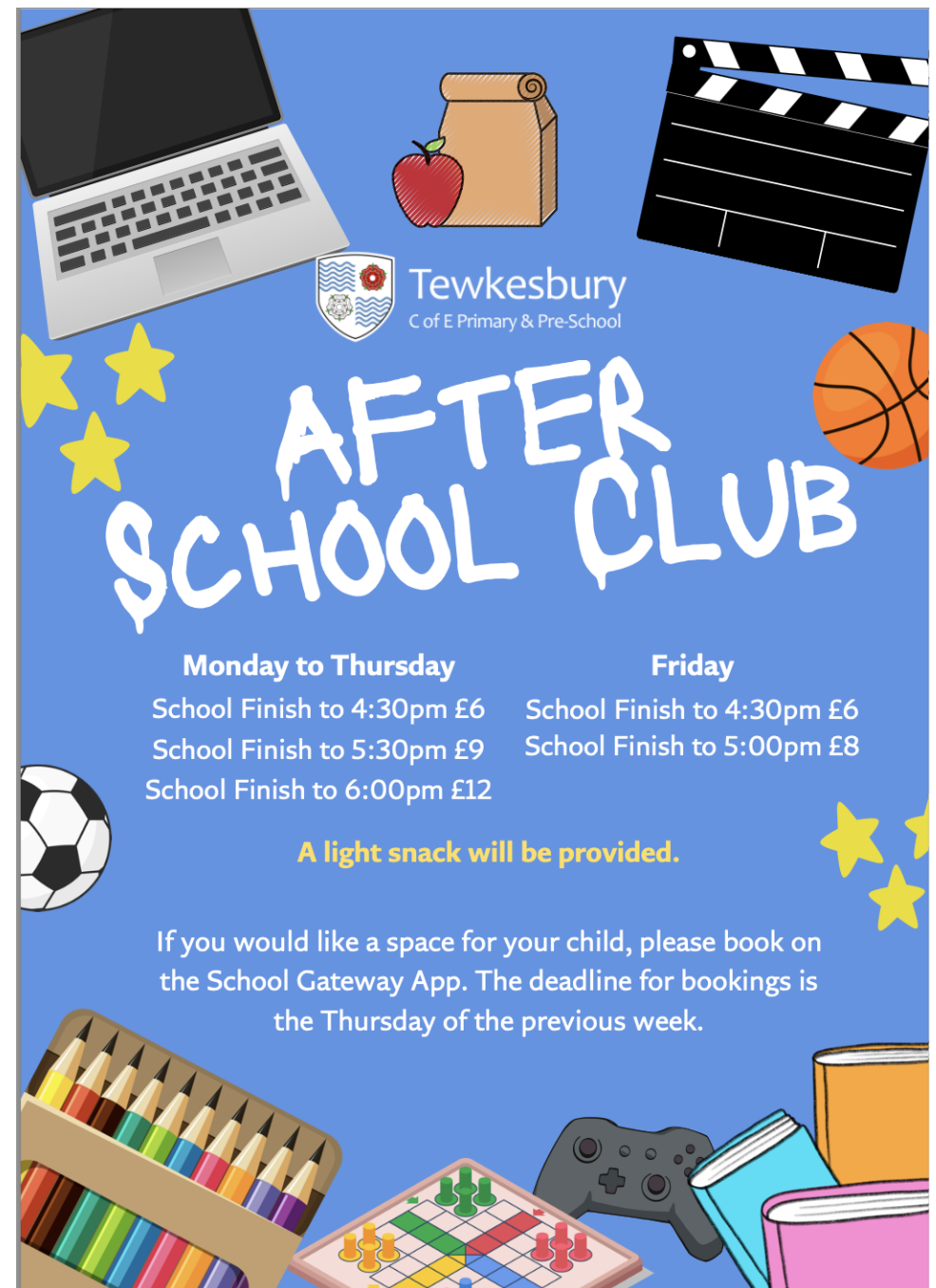
